

Martínez Lacuesta Rioja Gran Reserva



Description:

Martínez Lacuesta Rioja Gran Reserva is a distinguished red wine from the heart of Rioja, blending Tempranillo with small proportions of Graciano and Mazuelo. Aged for a minimum of 24 months in American oak barrels followed by at least 36 months in bottle, this wine exemplifies the traditional craftsmanship and ageing potential characteristic of Rioja's Gran Reserva classification.

Tasting notes:

Enticing aromas of ripe black cherry, dried plum, and subtle notes of leather and tobacco. The palate is full-bodied and harmonious, with layers of dark fruit, hints of spice, and velvety tannins leading to a long, elegant finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

- Roast lamb with rosemary and garlic
- Grilled ribeye steak
- Aged Manchego cheese
- Mushroom and truffle risotto
- Charcuterie platter with chorizo and jamón ibérico
