

Baias Wine Tsitska-Tsol



Description:

Baias Wine Tsitska-Tsol is a natural white blend from the Imereti region of western Georgia, combining two indigenous grape varieties: Tsitska and Tsolikouri. Produced by a small, family-run winery using traditional Georgian methods with minimal intervention, this wine is made with spontaneous fermentation and low sulphur, offering a textured and characterful profile that reflects both grape and place.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of yellow pear, chamomile, and dried herbs. The palate is dry and slightly grippy, with notes of quince, citrus peel, and apricot, supported by fresh acidity and a lightly nutty finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled chicken with herbs
- Vegetable stews
- Georgian khachapuri
- Lentil salad
- Soft-rind cheeses

Talking Point:

Made by young winemakers reviving ancient Georgian practices, this blend of Tsitska and Tsolikouri is fermented with native yeasts and bottled unfiltered. It's a great introduction to Georgia's vibrant natural wine scene, with structure and depth from traditional techniques rather than oak or additives.
