

Description:

Melnik 55 is a distinctive red blend from Bulgaria, crafted predominantly from the indigenous Melnik grape, also known as Shiroka Melnishka. Named after the grape's 55mm berry size, this wine showcases the unique character of the Thracian Valley's warm climate and rugged terroir.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of ripe blackberry, black pepper, and hints of smoked herbs. The palate is medium to full-bodied, with juicy dark fruit, a touch of spice, and smooth, well-integrated tannins leading to a long, savoury finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled meats, especially lamb or pork
- Hearty stews
- Aged hard cheeses
- Roasted vegetables with herbs
- Spiced sausages

Talking Point:

Melnik 55 highlights Bulgaria's oldest and most prized red grape, known for its thick skins and intense flavours. The wine's name pays homage to the unusually large grape berries, reflecting the region's tradition and the grape's distinctive personality.
