

Tsarev Brod Ice Riesling (Half Bottle)



Description:

Tsarev Brod Ice Riesling is a luscious dessert wine produced by the family-owned Tsarev Brod winery in the Shumen region of Bulgaria, close to the Black Sea coast. Made from 100% Riesling grapes hand-harvested when naturally frozen on the vine, the frozen berries are slowly pressed to concentrate sugars. After a gentle, extended fermentation and 12-month ageing in used oak barrels, the wine offers a harmonious blend of sweetness and structure.

Tasting notes:

- **Colour:** Rich golden amber.
- **Aroma:** Enticing scents of fig jam, raisins, candied orange peel, quince, dried flowers and honey.
- **Palate:** Sumptuously sweet yet balanced by crisp acidity. Flavours of apricot, quince and beeswax linger into a long, honeyed-acacia finish.

Allergens:

Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Fruit-based desserts (e.g. pear tart or pumpkin pie)
- Foie gras or pâté
- Crème brûlée or lemon cake
- Blue cheese or aged triple-cream cheeses
- Dark chocolate (>70% cocoa) or chocolate mousse

Talking Point:

Tsarev Brod's Ice Riesling leverages the winemaker's expertise in ice-wine production. The method of harvesting fully frozen grapes, followed by a slow gentle pressing and oak maturation, results in a dessert wine with richness yet vivid freshness. Despite the natural sweetness, the wine retains elegant acidity and finesse — a style praised for balancing indulgence with precision
