

## Chateau la Brande



### **Description:**

Château La Brande Castillon is a robust red from the Castillon - Côtes de Bordeaux appellation, blending Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Cabernet Sauvignon. The vineyard's clay and limestone soils contribute to its structure and depth. Aged in French oak barrels, this wine offers excellent ageing potential while expressing the character of Bordeaux's right bank.

### **Tasting notes:**

Aromas of black cherry, blackberry, and spice with hints of cedar and earth. The palate is full-bodied and smooth, showing ripe dark fruit, subtle tobacco, and well-integrated tannins, finishing with a long, polished finish.

**Allergens:** Contains sulphites.

### **Dish Pairing:**

- Slow-cooked beef stew
- Roast duck with berry sauce
- Chargrilled pork chops
- Hard goat's cheese
- Wild mushroom tart

### **Talking Point:**

Situated just across the Dordogne from Saint-Émilion, Château La Brande Castillon benefits from cooler temperatures and diverse soils that add complexity. The estate blends tradition with attention to detail, making wines that often surprise for their elegance and approachability at a great value.
