

Chateau de Rochemorin 2012 Double Magnum



Description:

Château de Rochemorin is a historic estate in the Pessac-Léognan appellation of Bordeaux, owned by the Lurton family. The 2012 vintage, presented here in an impressive double magnum format, is a classic Left Bank red dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon, offering structure, depth, and graceful ageing. The gravelly soils typical of the region contribute to the wine's elegance and minerality, while the larger bottle size ensures slower maturation and added complexity over time.

Tasting notes:

Notes of blackcurrant, tobacco, and forest floor on the nose. The palate shows ripe plum, cedar, graphite, and earthy spice, with supple tannins and a lingering, smoky finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing: Roast lamb, grilled duck breast, mushroom risotto, beef Wellington, lentil stew, aged Comté

Talking Point:

Château de Rochemorin once belonged to the philosopher Charles Louis de Secondat, Baron de Montesquieu—adding a layer of historical intrigue to this elegant and age-worthy claret.
