

Description:

Tollot-Beaut Chorey-lès-Beaune 2012 is a refined red Burgundy from one of the region's respected family domaines. From the village of Chorey-lès-Beaune, this vintage offers elegance and maturity, balancing delicate fruit with the savoury nuances that develop over time.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of red cherry, forest floor, and subtle spice. The palate reveals flavours of raspberry, dried herbs, and a hint of truffle, with fine tannins and a silky, lingering finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Roast duck with cherries
- Cog au vin
- Grilled salmon
- Mushroom fricassée
- Soft-rind cheeses

Talking Point:

Tollot-Beaut has been family-run since the 19th century and was among the first Burgundy domaines to bottle its own wines. The 2012 vintage from Chorey-lès-Beaune shows the benefits of patient ageing, with tertiary notes adding depth to the wine's graceful fruit core.
