

Description:

Cantine Povero Cabanè Langhe DOC is a structured red from Piedmont, crafted by the Povero family estate, which has been producing wine for generations. It reflects the elegance and depth of the Langhe hills, offering a wine of both character and approachability.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of red cherry, blackberry, and dried herbs. The palate shows flavours of plum, spice, and a touch of leather, framed by fine tannins and a persistent finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Tagliatelle with meat ragu
- Braised beef cheeks
- Mature alpine cheeses
- Truffle risotto
- Roasted game birds

Talking Point:

Cantine Povero has cultivated vineyards in Piedmont since 1837, with a focus on traditional methods and sustainable practices. Cabanè captures the essence of the Langhe, combining ripe fruit with the savoury complexity that defines wines from this historic region.
