

Description:

Chassagne-Montrachet Les Chênes Rouge from Domaine Philippe Colin is a finely crafted Pinot Noir from a village best known for its whites. Grown in the Les Chênes vineyard on limestone-clay soils, the wine is fermented with native yeasts and aged in French oak to bring depth and finesse to this elegant red Burgundy.

Tasting notes:

Delicate aromas of red cherry, raspberry, and crushed rose petals, with subtle notes of earth and spice. The palate is silky and well-balanced, offering fresh red fruit, fine-grained tannins, and a savoury, mineral edge.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Duck confit
- Roast guinea fowl
- Mushroom and thyme tart
- Comté cheese
- Grilled salmon with lentils

Talking Point:

Philippe Colin, known for his expressive Chassagne whites, brings the same precision and detail to this rare village red. Les Chênes Rouge shows that Pinot Noir from Chassagne-Montrachet can be every bit as refined and site-driven as its more famous white counterparts.
