

Description:

Domaine Didier Dagueneau Pur Sang 2020 is a biodynamic Sauvignon Blanc from the Pouilly-Fumé appellation in the Loire Valley. Crafted by the late Didier Dagueneau and continued by his son Louis-Benjamin, this cuvée is renowned for its purity and expressive minerality.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of lemon zest, white peach, and subtle herbal notes. The palate reveals flavours of chalk, flint, and candied lemon, with a crystalline texture and vibrant acidity. The finish is long and mouthwatering, showcasing the wine's mineral backbone.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled lobster with garlic butter
- Seared scallops with lemon beurre blanc
- Goat cheese salad with citrus dressing
- · Sushi with wasabi and pickled ginger
- Herb-crusted chicken with roasted vegetables

Talking Point:

The name "Pur Sang" translates to "thoroughbred," reflecting the wine's noble lineage and the Dagueneau family's commitment to producing exceptional Sauvignon Blanc. The grapes are sourced from old vines planted in flint-rich soils, contributing to the wine's distinctive minerality and aging potential.
