

Description:

Cambon La Pelouse Cru Bourgeois is a well-regarded Médoc wine from Bordeaux, situated between Margaux and Saint-Julien. Known for producing supple, approachable clarets, this estate balances ripe fruit with classic Left Bank structure.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of cassis, blackberry, and cedar. The palate shows black cherry, tobacco, and a touch of spice, with polished tannins and a smooth, lingering finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

- Roast leg of lamb
- Duck confit
- Grilled ribeye steak
- Mushroom and lentil pie
- Hard cheeses such as Manchego

Talking Point:

Cambon La Pelouse has built a reputation as one of the best-performing Cru Bourgeois estates, consistently delivering wines that punch above their classification.
