

Vriniotis Methea

**Description:**

Vriniotis Methea is a fresh and characterful white wine from the island of Evia, Greece. Crafted by the Vriniotis family estate, it highlights the vibrancy and aromatic intensity that the region's coastal vineyards are known for.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of citrus blossom, peach, and wild herbs. The palate delivers flavours of ripe apricot, lemon zest, and a touch of saline minerality, with bright acidity and a crisp, lingering finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled sea bream
- Greek salad with feta
- Courgette fritters with tzatziki
- Prawn saganaki
- Lemon and herb roast chicken

Talking Point:

The Vriniotis family has farmed vineyards on the northern tip of Evia for generations, with a focus on indigenous varieties and traditional methods. *Methea* takes its name from an ancient city on the island, underlining the deep cultural roots of winemaking in this part of Greece.
