

Domaine de Chevalier Rouge 2005



Description:

Domaine de Chevalier Rouge 2005 is a distinguished Grand Cru Classé de Graves from Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux. The 2005 vintage is widely regarded as one of the finest of the decade, producing deeply structured wines with power, elegance, and exceptional ageing potential.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of blackcurrant, cedar, and tobacco. The palate reveals layers of dark plum, graphite, and earthy spice, framed by firm yet refined tannins and a long, complex finish. Matured beautifully, it now shows both richness and secondary notes of leather and cigar box.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Roast rib of beef
- Duck breast with red wine reduction
- Truffle-infused dishes
- Aged Comté or Gruyère
- Wild mushroom ragout

Talking Point:

Domaine de Chevalier is unusual among Bordeaux classified growths for being located in a clearing of woodland rather than surrounded by endless vineyards. This setting helps shelter the vines and contributes to the estate's distinctive style. The 2005 vintage has earned a place in collectors' cellars worldwide, admired for its structure, balance, and remarkable longevity.
