Description:

Famille Laudet Brume Rosé is a delicate rosé from Gascony in south-west France. Light and refreshing, it captures the easy-going style of the region with bright fruit and crisp freshness, making it an ideal choice for relaxed summer drinking.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of strawberry, redcurrant, and citrus zest. The palate shows flavours of raspberry and watermelon, with lively acidity and a clean, dry finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled prawns with lemon
- Tomato and basil salad
- Goat's cheese crostini
- Ratatouille
- Fresh berry tart

Talking Point:

The Laudet family has been rooted in Gascony since the 17th century, originally known for Armagnac before expanding into wines. *Brume*—meaning "mist"—pays tribute to the morning fogs that drift across the vineyards, helping preserve freshness in the grapes and shaping the vibrant character of this rosé.
