

Description:

Sorby Adams Pinot Gris is crafted in the cool-climate Eden Valley of South Australia. This region's altitude and cooler nights allow the grapes to ripen slowly, building flavour while retaining crisp natural acidity.

Tasting notes:

Fresh aromas of pear, apple, and citrus blossom. The palate is lively and refreshing, with flavours of stone fruit and a touch of spice, balanced by a clean, dry finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled prawns with lemon and herbs
- Thai green curry
- Roast chicken with garlic butter
- Summer vegetable stir-fry
- Soft cheeses such as brie

Talking Point:

Winemaker Simon Adams founded Sorby Adams after more than 20 years in the Barossa, with a focus on small-lot wines that highlight individual vineyard character. This Pinot Gris comes from elevated Eden Valley sites, where cooler conditions give the wine its lifted aromatics and crisp structure.
