

Zavec Brothers Pinot Gris



Description:

Zavec Brothers Pinot Gris Skin Contact is an orange wine from Slovenia's Štajerska region. Crafted by Zavec Brothers, this wine undergoes wild fermentation with extended skin contact, followed by six months of barrel aging on its lees, resulting in a textured and expressive profile.

Tasting notes:

The wine presents a complex nose of red berries, wild strawberries, peach, and a touch of mint tea. On the palate, it offers a creamy texture with flavours of bruised pear, orange zest, and a faint hint of spice, culminating in a bone-dry, slightly salty finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.
