

Estrelles de Batea Blanc



Description:

Estrelles de Batea Blanc is a white wine from Celler Alimara in Terra Alta, Catalunya. It is made entirely from Garnatxa Blanca (White Grenache). The grapes are fermented in stainless steel, then matured on lees in an old oak foudre to build texture without overwhelming the fruit.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of apricot, pear, and a hint of raw honey. On the palate it has good weight and texture, with orchard fruit flavours and a crisp finish. A lingering apple note rounds things off cleanly and dry.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Paella or rice dishes
- Grilled chicken
- Dishes with garlic & herbs (e.g. garlic hummus)
- Mild cheeses
- Seafood or shellfish

Talking Point:

What sets this wine apart is its maturation in a large old oak foudre, which adds subtle complexity and texture to the clean fruit of the Garnatxa Blanca. Celler Alimara practices sustainable viticulture, working organically, avoiding filtration and fining wherever possible, and focusing on authentic expression of their Mediterranean climate and calcareous clay soils.
