

Estrelles de Batea Negre



Description:

Estrelles de Batea Negre is a red wine from Celler Alimara, located in the Terra Alta region of Catalonia. It is made from 100% Garnatxa Negra (Grenache) grapes, fermented in stainless steel to preserve the fresh fruit character. The wine is then aged for 8 months in a large old oak foudre, enhancing its texture and complexity without overpowering the fruit.

Tasting Notes:

The wine presents aromas of ripe red berries, such as raspberry and cherry, with subtle hints of spice from the oak aging. On the palate, it is medium-bodied with soft tannins, balanced acidity, and a smooth finish, making it an approachable and easy-drinking red.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Talking Point:

The name "Estrelles de Batea" translates to "Stars of Batea," reflecting the winery's commitment to showcasing the unique terroir of the Terra Alta region. By using organic and sustainable farming practices, Celler Alimara aims to produce wines that authentically express the Mediterranean climate and calcareous clay soils of their vineyards.
