

Torres Pazo das Bruxas Albarino



Description:

Torres Pazo das Bruxas Albariño is a crisp, aromatic white from Galicia's famed Rías Baixas region in northwest Spain. Made from 100% Albariño grapes grown near the Atlantic coast, it captures the essence of the ocean with its saline freshness and zesty citrus character. Pale straw in colour, the wine shows expressive aromas of white peach, green apple, and orange blossom, balanced by lively acidity and a clean, mineral finish.

Tasting Notes:

White Peach, Green Apple, Lemon Peel, Orange Blossom, Saline, Mineral

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Galician-style octopus (*pulpo a la gallega*)
- Grilled prawns or shellfish
- Goat's cheese salad
- Lemon and herb roast chicken

Talking Point:

"Pazo das Bruxas" translates as *House of the Witches*, a playful nod to the folklore of Galicia, a land rich in myths and legends. The name reflects the mystical charm of the region's misty vineyards, where the cool Atlantic breezes and granite soils give Albariño its distinctive freshness and maritime character.
