

Description:

Maison Bihan Touraine Sauvignon Blanc comes from the Loire Valley, a region renowned for producing crisp and aromatic whites. Pale straw in colour, this wine expresses vibrant notes of citrus, green apple, and gooseberry, with subtle hints of flint and fresh herbs. Light-bodied yet zesty, it delivers a refreshing finish that highlights the Loire's mineral-rich soils.

Tasting Notes:

Gooseberry, Green Apple, Lemon Zest, Grass, Flint, Herbaceous Notes

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Goat's cheese salad
- Steamed mussels with garlic and herbs
- Grilled asparagus
- Light fish dishes such as sole or cod

Talking Point:

Maison Bihan takes its name from the Breton word *Bihan*, meaning "small", reflecting the estate's hands-on approach to viticulture. The Touraine appellation, sitting along the Loire River, benefits from a mix of limestone and flint soils that give Sauvignon Blanc its signature minerality and crispness, making this wine a classic example of the region's style.
