

Description:

Château Musar Jeune Red is a vibrant, unoaked red wine from the Bekaa Valley, Lebanon, made from a blend of Cinsault, Syrah, and Cabernet Sauvignon. Unlike the estate's flagship wines, this cuvée is crafted for early drinking, offering pure fruit expression with a Mediterranean flair.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of cherry, blackcurrant, and spice with a hint of earthiness. The palate is juicy and medium-bodied, with flavours of ripe red berries, plum, and soft tannins leading to a smooth finish.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Moussaka

- Charcuterie boards
- Roasted aubergine

Talking Point:

Musar Jeune is made by the iconic Château Musar, but from younger vines and without oak ageing—allowing the character of the Bekaa Valley to shine through more directly. It's a fascinating introduction to the estate's signature blend, offering the boldness of Lebanon's sun-drenched vineyards in a more immediate, fruit-forward style.
