

Fontanario De Pegoes Tinto



Description:

Fontanário de Pegões Tinto is a smooth and generous red blend from the Palmela region of Portugal, just south of Lisbon. Made primarily from Castelão, Trincadeira, and Aragonez (Tempranillo), it's a deep ruby wine offering ripe red fruit aromas with hints of spice and vanilla. Medium-bodied and supple, it shows balanced tannins and a rounded finish, making it an easy-drinking yet characterful everyday red.

Tasting Notes:

Red Cherry, Plum, Spice, Vanilla, Soft Tannins

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

- Tomato-based pasta dishes
- Roasted vegetables
- Semi-hard cheeses

Talking Point:

The Pegões Cooperative was founded in the 1950s as part of a land development project initiated by Portugal's government to support local farmers. Today, it's recognised for producing exceptional value wines that champion native Portuguese grape varieties, reflecting both tradition and innovation from one of the country's most reliable cooperatives.
