

## **Description:**

Pierre Brisset Bourgogne Côte d'Or Pinot Noir is a beautifully balanced red that captures the elegance and energy of Burgundy's heartland. Sourced from vineyards around Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet, it offers more depth and refinement than many regional wines. Bright ruby in colour, it opens with aromas of red cherry, raspberry, and gentle spice. The palate is silky and pure, with fine tannins and a fresh, lingering finish that highlights its Côte d'Or origins.
