Description:

Beykush Amphora Riesling is a dry white wine from the Mykolaiv region of southern Ukraine, produced by Beykush Winery on the Beykush Peninsula near the Black Sea. Made from 100% Riesling, it is fermented and aged in clay amphoras, which enhances texture and purity while preserving the grape's natural aromatics. Limited production makes it a distinctive expression of coastal Ukrainian winemaking.

Wild Flowers, Green Apple, Apricot, Kiwi, Citrus Zest, Mineral Finish

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled prawns or shellfish with lemon
- Pan-seared white fish with herbs
- Soft goat's cheese
- Aperitif served chilled at 10-12°C

Talking Point:

Beykush Winery is known for its experimental and artisanal approach, combining international grape varieties with innovative techniques. The amphora ageing brings subtle complexity and texture without oak influence, while the peninsula's unique maritime climate adds freshness and salinity — hallmarks of this pioneering Ukrainian estate.
