

Description:

Beykush Pinotage is a red wine produced by Beykush Winery on the Beykush Peninsula in southern Ukraine, overlooking the Black Sea. Made entirely from Pinotage, the South African grape variety, this wine reflects both the estate's innovative spirit and the moderating maritime climate that gives the fruit freshness and balance. It's an elegant and expressive interpretation of a grape rarely seen outside its homeland.

Tasting Notes:

Ripe Strawberry, Plum, Red Berry, Raisin, Subtle Spice, Light Toast

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled lamb or pork steaks
- Game birds or rabbit

Talking Point:

Beykush Pinotage is believed to be the only Pinotage produced in Ukraine. The vines were planted as part of the winery's experimental approach to exploring how international varieties adapt to local conditions. The result is a lighter, more aromatic expression of Pinotage, shaped by coastal breezes and mineral-rich soils — a testament to Ukraine's growing reputation for bold, creative winemaking.
