

Carpathian Sekt Blaufränkisch Rosé Brut



Description:

Carpathian Sekt Blaufränkisch Rosé Brut is a dry sparkling wine from the Chateau Chizay estate in the Zakarpattia region of western Ukraine. Made entirely from the Blaufränkisch grape variety, it shows a delicate pink hue with fine, persistent bubbles. The wine combines freshness and elegance, expressing the cool Carpathian climate through its vibrant fruit and balanced structure.

Tasting Notes:

Fresh Red Berries, Strawberry, Rose Petal, Peony, Crisp Acidity

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Fresh strawberries or raspberry desserts
- Grilled prawns or shellfish
- Light salads with berries or goat's cheese
- Aperitif before a main course

Talking Point:

Produced in the foothills of the Carpathian Mountains, this sparkling rosé reflects the growing reputation of western Ukraine for cool-climate winemaking. Chateau Chizay's Carpathian Sekt range is recognised domestically for its precision and freshness, made using the traditional method to highlight the purity of local fruit and the region's mountain influence.
