

Villa Tinta Sukholimanskiy



Description:

Villa Tinta Sukholimanskiy is a white wine from the Bolhrad region in southern Ukraine, crafted from the indigenous Sukholimanskiy grape. The wine is pale straw in colour, showing freshness and balance, with a focus on purity of fruit. It is made to highlight the regional character and the cool influences of the nearby Black Sea.

Tasting Notes:

Green Apple, White Peach, Citrus Zest, Light Herb, Mineral

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled white fish or shellfish
- Chicken with herb butter
- Light pasta dishes with cream or vegetables
- Soft cheeses such as Brie or goat's cheese

Talking Point:

Sukholimanskiy is an indigenous grape variety of southern Ukraine, particularly in the Odesa and Bolhrad regions. Villa Tinta's bottling demonstrates how this native variety can produce fresh, aromatic wines with balanced acidity and regional expression, reflecting the evolving sophistication of Ukrainian viticulture.
