

Description:

Muses Winery Assyrtiko is a dry white wine crafted from pure Assyrtiko grapes grown in mainland Greece's Viotia region, near the historic Valley of the Muses. This single-varietal bottling is made with a focus on minimal intervention—wild yeast fermentation, gentle lees ageing, and no overreliance on oak—aiming to honour the grape's purity and origin.

Tasting notes:

Pale straw in colour with luminous clarity. On the nose, expect crisp aromas of lemon zest, green apple and river pebble minerality. The palate is precise and invigorating—lemon citrus meets tart yellow apple, framed by flinty mineral tones and finishing with vibrant acidity and a clean, lingering lift.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled prawns with garlic & lemon
- Octopus salad with crushed anise
- Light shellfish pasta (e.g. clams)
- Feta-topped cucumber salad
- Steamed white fish with herb vinaigrette

Talking Point:

This Assyrtiko shines by letting the grape speak for itself—without oak influence or heavy winemaking techniques. It delivers the variety's famed high acidity and mineral clarity, with leesaged texture adding depth. Ideal for those seeking a palate-cleanser white with both crispness and subtle complexity.
