

Description:

Chambers Rosewood Rutherglen Muscat is crafted by the Chambers family, who have been producing fortified wines in Rutherglen, Victoria since the 1850s. Made from Muscat à Petits Grains Rouge grapes, it is slowly matured in old casks using a fractional solera-style system, creating extraordinary depth and concentration. Expect aromas of raisin, caramel, rose petal and dried fig, with a rich, velvety palate that balances intense sweetness with lifted spice and a long, warming finish.

Tasting Notes:

Raisin, Caramel, Rose Petal, Dried Fig, Molasses, Warm Spice

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Sticky toffee pudding
- Strong blue cheeses
- Dark chocolate torte
- Nut-based desserts such as pecan tart

Talking Point:

Rutherglen Muscat is one of Australia's most iconic wine styles, and the Chambers family are among its most respected custodians. Their century-old casks form a living library of vintages, some containing wines started by previous generations — a rare example of true multi-generational ageing influencing a wine's character.
