Matawhero Pinot Gris is an aromatic, full-bodied white from Gisborne on New Zealand's North Island. Produced from a single vineyard known for its silt-over-clay soils, the wine is crafted to highlight purity of fruit and natural richness. Pale straw with a hint of gold, it offers generous aromatics and a textural palate, reflecting Gisborne's reputation for producing expressive, fruit-forward white wines.

Tasting Notes:

Pear, Lychee, Honeysuckle, Almond, Subtle Spice, Dry Finish

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled white fish with herb butter
- Pork loin with pear and almond salad
- Lightly spiced Asian dishes
- Creamy pasta with fresh herbs

Talking Point:

Matawhero is one of Gisborne's pioneering wineries, known for championing single-vineyard expressions. Their Pinot Gris comes from a dry-farmed site that naturally limits yields, resulting in concentrated fruit and a distinctive aromatic profile. This focus on a single parcel gives the wine a clear sense of place and character.

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
