

Domaine Jean-Max Roger Vieilles Vignes Sancerre Blanc



Description:

Domaine Jean-Max Roger Vieilles Vignes Sancerre Blanc is a refined and expressive Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire, crafted with grapes drawn from older vines. The wine is pale straw in colour and offers a beautifully balanced profile, combining mineral precision with vibrant fruit character. The use of mature vines adds depth and complexity beyond a typical Sancerre, resulting in a wine that feels both elegant and nuanced.

Tasting Notes:

Gooseberry, Green Apple, Citrus Zest, Flint, White Flowers, Light Herbaceous Edge

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Oysters or shellfish
- Goat's cheese tart or salad (classic pairing with Sancerre)
- Grilled sea bream or sole with lemon and herbs
- Light vegetable dishes or salads with citrus vinaigrette

Talking Point:

"Vieilles Vignes" refers to the old vine parcels used by Jean-Max Roger, older vines often yield lower quantities but greater concentration and complexity in the grapes. This Sancerre Blanc showcases how mature Loire vines can produce Sauvignon Blanc with heightened depth and sculpted minerality, making it a standout example of the varietal beyond simple freshness.
