

Description:

Domaine Jean-Max Roger Vieilles Vignes Sancerre Rouge is a red wine from the Loire Valley, made entirely from Pinot Noir grown on older vine parcels. The wine is light to medium in body and exhibits the refined, terroir-driven style typical of Sancerre's reds. It delivers freshness and subtlety rather than overt power — a delicate, graceful red.

Tasting Notes:

Red Cherry, Raspberry, Red Currant, Wild Strawberry, Earth, Light Spice, Silky Tannins

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Roast duck or chicken
- Mushroom risotto or dishes with earthy mushrooms
- Light game birds such as quail or pigeon
- Soft to medium cheeses such as Brie or young goat cheese

Talking Point:

"Vieilles Vignes" (old vines) means the grapes come from older, lower-yielding vines, which often impart greater concentration and complexity. In a region better known for whites, this Sancerre Rouge shows how mature Loire Pinot Noir can produce elegant and expressive reds — offering a lighter, more nuanced alternative to heavier Burgundian or Rhône wines.
