

Description:

Pol Roger *Sir Winston Churchill* is the prestige cuvée of the renowned Champagne house, created in tribute to their most famous admirer. Made only in exceptional vintages, it is dominated by Pinot Noir with a supporting proportion of Chardonnay — though the exact blend is a closely guarded secret. The wine is aged for an extended period on its lees, giving it remarkable depth, power, and finesse. Rich, complex and beautifully structured, it is one of Champagne's most celebrated luxury cuvées.

Tasting Notes:

Brioche, Toasted Almond, Citrus Peel, White Peach, Hazelnut, Subtle Spice, Long Creamy Finish

Dish Pairing:

- Lobster with butter
- Roast chicken or guinea fowl
- Sole meunière
- Aged hard cheeses such as Comté

Talking Point:

Winston Churchill was famously devoted to Pol Roger Champagne, even naming one of his racehorses "Pol Roger." After his death, the house created this cuvée in his honour, designed to reflect the qualities he admired most: robustness, structure, and elegance. The exact vineyard sources remain confidential, adding to the mystique of one of Champagne's most iconic prestige bottlings.
