Hattingley Valley *The English Gent* is a fresh, aromatic English sparkling wine made predominantly from Pinot Gris and Bacchus — an unusual but expressive combination. Crafted using the traditional method, it delivers a lively, fruit-driven style with fine bubbles and bright acidity. The Pinot Gris provides weight and ripe orchard fruit, while the Bacchus brings vibrant aromatics and a zesty lift. The result is an easy-drinking yet characterful sparkling wine that showcases England's versatility beyond the classic Champagne grapes.

Tasting Notes:

Pear, Elderflower, Lemon Zest, Green Apple, Honeysuckle, Light Biscuit Notes, Crisp Finish

Talking Point:

The English Gent highlights Hattingley Valley's playful, exploratory side. Instead of relying on the traditional Champagne trio, this cuvée champions two grapes that thrive in England's cool climate — especially Bacchus, often compared to a cross between Sauvignon Blanc and Riesling for its aromatic lift. It's a distinctive expression of English sparkling winemaking, offering something both refreshing and uniquely regional.
