

Charles Frey Pinot Noir



Description:

Charles Frey Pinot Noir is a bright, elegant red wine from Alsace, produced by one of the region's pioneering biodynamic estates. Made from 100% Pinot Noir, it is typically lighter and fresher in style than many Burgundian examples, with emphasis on purity of fruit and natural balance. Pale ruby in colour, it offers lively red fruit, gentle spice and a supple, easy-drinking structure.

Tasting Notes:

Red Cherry, Raspberry, Cranberry, Subtle Spice, Light Earth, Soft Tannins

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Roast chicken or turkey
- Charcuterie and cured meats
- Mushroom dishes or vegetable tarts
- Soft cheeses such as Munster or Brie

Talking Point:

Domaine Charles Frey was the first estate in Alsace to be certified biodynamic, a milestone that helped shape the region's modern approach to sustainable viticulture. Their Pinot Noir reflects this philosophy, focusing on freshness and transparency rather than power, and shows how Alsace can produce refined, characterful reds alongside its more famous aromatic whites.
