

Pope Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



Description:

Pope Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a structured and expressive red from the cooler, high-altitude vineyards of Napa Valley. Deep ruby in colour, it offers concentrated dark berry fruit, including blackcurrant and blackberry, complemented by notes of cedar, vanilla and subtle tobacco. Firm tannins and balanced acidity provide both richness and elegance, making it approachable now but capable of developing further complexity with a few years of ageing.

Tasting notes:

Blackcurrant, Blackberry, Cedar, Vanilla, Tobacco, Dark Chocolate

Allergens:

Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled ribeye steak
- Braised short ribs
- Hard cheeses such as aged Cheddar or Comté
- Mushroom and herb tart

Talking Point:

Pope Valley's vineyards are located in one of Napa Valley's most secluded sub-regions, with higher elevation and cooler nights than the valley floor. This diurnal shift allows Cabernet Sauvignon grapes to ripen fully while retaining bright acidity, producing a wine that combines concentration with freshness—a style that stands out among Napa Cabernets.
