

Pope Valley Faultline



Description:

Pope Valley Faultline is a bold red blend from the high-altitude vineyards of Napa Valley, named for the geological fault that shapes the valley's soils. Deep ruby in colour, it combines ripe dark berries, plum, and cassis with subtle layers of mocha, spice, and cedar. The wine is structured yet approachable, with firm tannins balanced by bright acidity, offering both immediate pleasure and potential for short-term ageing.

Tasting notes:

Blackberry, Plum, Cassis, Cedar, Mocha, Spice

Allergens:

Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Grilled lamb chops
- Braised short ribs
- Mushroom and beef stew
- Hard cheeses like aged Cheddar or Gruyère

Talking Point:

The "Faultline" name reflects Pope Valley's unique position along a seismic fault that contributes to exceptionally well-draining, mineral-rich soils. This geological feature influences vine stress, helping concentrate fruit flavours and creating a red blend with depth, structure, and a distinctly expressive character unique to the region.
