

## Godessa Assyrtiko



### **Description:**

Godessa Assyrtiko is a bright and mineral-driven white wine that showcases the naturally crisp character of Greece's flagship white grape. Pale lemon in colour, it opens with citrus, green apple and white peach aromas, alongside subtle saline and herbal notes. The palate is fresh and focused, with vibrant acidity and a clean, textured finish that gives the wine both energy and versatility at the table.

Lemon, Green Apple, White Peach, Saline Notes, Fresh Herbs, Mineral

Contains sulphites.

- Grilled octopus
- Fried calamari
- Lemon and herb chicken

### **Talking Point:**

Assyrtiko is best known for its origins on the volcanic island of Santorini, where vines are traditionally trained into basket-shaped coils to protect them from strong winds. While Godessa is produced on the mainland, the wine reflects the grape's trademark high acidity and mineral character, qualities that have made Assyrtiko one of the fastest-growing and most internationally recognised Greek varieties in modern winemaking.
