

Bedoba Orange



Description:

Bedoba Orange is an amber wine from Georgia, produced using traditional techniques that date back thousands of years. Made from indigenous Georgian white grape varieties and fermented with extended skin contact, it displays a deep golden-orange hue and a distinctive combination of fruit, spice and savoury complexity. The palate is textured and dry, with notes of dried apricot, orange peel and tea-like tannins balanced by fresh acidity and a long, structured finish.

Tasting notes:

Dried Apricot, Orange Peel, Peach, Honey, Black Tea, Spice

Allergens:

Contains sulphites.

Dish Pairing:

- Roast chicken with spices
- Moroccan tagine
- Hard sheep's milk cheeses
- Grilled aubergine dishes

Talking Point:

Georgia is widely regarded as the birthplace of wine, with evidence of winemaking dating back over 8,000 years. Bedoba Orange draws inspiration from the country's ancient tradition of fermenting grapes with their skins in large clay vessels known as qvevri. The word "Bedoba" refers to a Georgian day of luck and fortune, and according to tradition, whatever happens on Bedoba is believed to influence the year ahead.
