Description:

Cape Wild Chenin Blanc is a fresh and expressive South African white wine that showcases the versatility of the country's signature grape variety. Pale straw in colour, it offers vibrant aromas of ripe pear, green apple and tropical fruit, with hints of citrus and white blossom. The palate is crisp and fruit-driven, balanced by refreshing acidity and a clean, lively finish, making it an easy-drinking and versatile white.

Talking Point:

South Africa has more Chenin Blanc planted than any other country in the world, with many vineyards dating back decades. Originally brought to the Cape by Dutch settlers in the 17th century, the variety, known locally as **Steen** for many years, has become the country's flagship white grape, producing styles that range from crisp and fruity to some of the world's most age-worthy white wines.
