Paul Anheuser Kreuznacher St. Martin Riesling Halbtrocken is a refined off-dry white wine from the Nahe region of Germany. Crafted by the 14th generation of the Anheuser family, this wine showcases the estate's commitment to quality and tradition.

Tasting notes:

Aromas of green apple, citrus zest, and subtle floral notes. The palate reveals flavours of ripe stone fruits and a touch of honey, balanced by refreshing acidity and a harmonious sweetness.

Allergens: Contains sulphites.

Talking Point:

The "St. Martin" vineyard, named after the former St. Martin's Monastery, is located in the fertile soils of Bad Kreuznach. These soils, rich in loess and gravel, contribute to the wine's depth and minerality. The estate's long-standing tradition and dedication to sustainable viticulture are evident in every bottle.
